WINTER LANTERN FESTIVAL

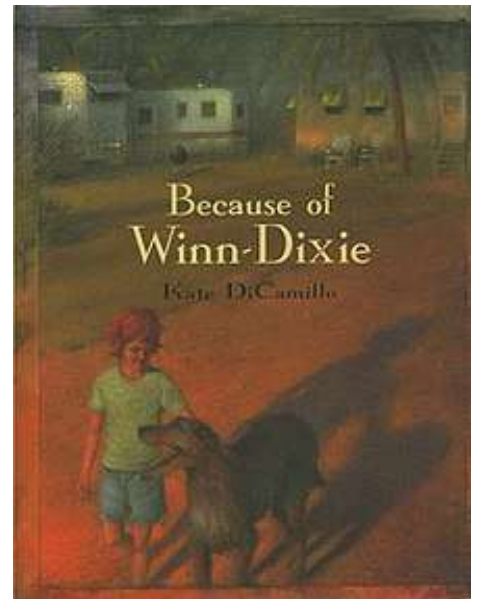

Cancellation & Refunds

Due to planning and staffing, we will not be able to accept cancellation after the program has started. Once your booking has been confirmed and the program has commenced, then you are obliged to pay for all the days selected, regardless of non-attendance. All bookings are non-refundable under any circumstances.

CCS

Little Wonder Kids is an approved and registered Australian childcare provider. Eligible parents may utilize the federal Governments Child Care Subsidy scheme for your services. In order for us to apply Child Care Subsidy to your account, you must provide us with both of your child's CRN number and the corresponding parent's CRN number. If you are not registered for Child Care Subsidy, please contact the Family Assistance Office on 13 61 50.

We will provide specific information to families about all planned excursions (such as destination, mode of transport, departure and return times, contact details and any other requirements.

What Should My Child Bring?

Food | Clothing | Footwear

Please ensure your child brings morning-tea, packed lunch and a refillable water bottle. We provide afternoon snack every day unless stated on the program menu.

Please ensure your child is dressed in comfortable appropriate clothing and shoes.

Health & Special Considerations

To ensure that we provide the best possible care for your child, we will require a copy of your child's immunisation records.

If your child/children suffer from anaphylaxis, asthma, allergies or any medically diagnosed condition you **MUST** provide a current medical management plan signed by your doctor with a recent colour photo of your child. Written information is required regarding any cultural, religious, dietary requirements or additional needs.

Behaviour

At Little Wonder Kids, we encourage positive behaviour at all times. Should a child's behaviour impact on the safety and well being of others, the parent, guardian or care giver will be contacted to discuss the behaviour and work towards implementing positive strategies to improve the behaviour and/or consider alternative arrangements.

Sun Smart

Little Wonder Kids, Sun Smart policy will be enforced from September through to April. Please ensure your child bring a hat during this period. Remember "No Hat, No Play & Stay In the Shade All Day!"

Children with Additional Needs

At Little Wonder Kids, we support children to participate in our holiday programs. In order to provide quality and responsive care that meets the need of a child with additional needs, we will require at least 4 weeks' notice prior to the start of the program to allow for funding and staffing. We treat each case individually and will make decisions based on the needs of the child, and availability of appropriately qualified staff and resources.
