## Professor Maths



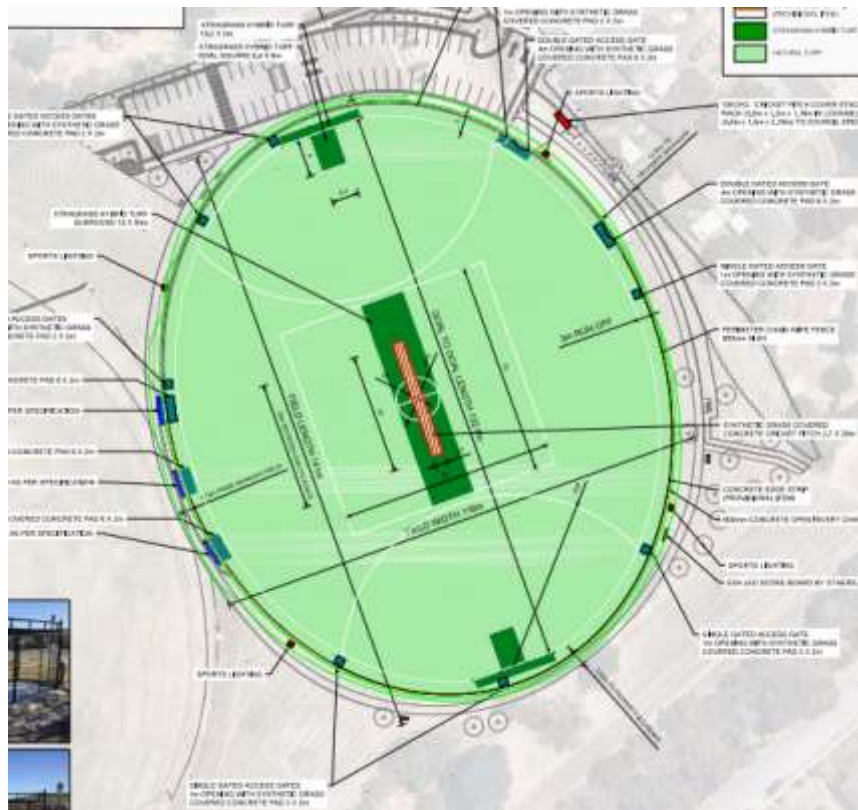
