Aussie Bread Tags for Wheelchairs

Bread Tags for Wheelchairs has been running in South Africa since 2006. They collect bread tags and sell them to a local plastics company. These tags are then made into seedling trays and the profit made through selling these, purchases wheelchairs for people in need. At present 500kg of bread tags are collected per month in South Africa, funding 2-3 wheelchairs!

Aussie Bread Tags for Wheelchairs began in August, 2018. The bread tags are sent to a plastics company in Robe, South Australia and the profits made are sent directly to South Africa to provide people in need with wheelchairs.

We are collecting bread tags here at school to help this cause. There will be a glass jar in the office foyer where they will be collected.
